This permit is issued pursuant to Sec. 32-1509 of the Murfreesboro City Code and International Property Maintenance Code which applies to movement of structures upon or across any state or highway and is subject to Ch. 1680-7-1-14 of the TDOT rules for overweight and over dimensional movements on TN highways. The building foundation, concrete sidewalks, driveways and all debris must be removed and site graded, seeded and strawed if located within the city limits. This permit becomes void if structure is not moved and property not cleared and graded within 10 working days of permit issuance.

MOVING PERMITS ARE VALID 10 DAYS FROM DATE OF ISSUANCE

(If the structure will be placed inside the city limits of Murfreesboro, please see the reverse side of this application)

The Following Items Must Be Completed Prior To Moving In Or Relocating A Structure In The City Of Murfreesboro

(Does Not Apply To Modular Structures)

- A Substandard Inspection must be performed on the structure by the City of Murfreesboro to evaluate it's condition.
The fee for this inspection is \$75.00
(Note: Substandard structures will not be permitted to be moved into the city)
 - A Move In/Remodel Permit, along with other required permits, must be obtained prior to moving in any approved structure in the city
 - A Certificate of Occupancy must be issued by the City of Murfreesboro prior to occupying the structure
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Section 32-1509 Restrictions on the movement of house or house trailer.

(A) No house or house trailer exceeding a length of forty feet extreme overall dimension, or a width of ninety-six inches extreme overall dimension, shall be towed or otherwise moved upon or across any street or highway between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., or 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., or during any period of darkness as defined in Code §32-1001. In addition, notice shall be given to the Murfreesboro Police Department twenty-four hours in advance. The applicant shall furnish escorts.

(B) Notwithstanding subsection (A), the Police Commissioner may direct the oversized load to be moved after 10:00 p.m. and provide a police escort in front and behind the oversized load through the City and charge two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per hour, two hundred dollars (\$200.00) minimum.
